Declaration of Paul Dehart

I, Paul DeHart, declare as follows:

1. I am Matthew DeHart's father, over the age of 18, and not a party to this action.
2. I offer this declaration in support of Matthew DeHart's petition for *habeas corpus*.
3. Matthew, my wife Leann, and myself crossed the border into Canada and applied for political asylum there on April 3, 2013.
4. On April 4, 2013, a bench warrant was issued for Matthew because he failed to appear at a pretrial conference in the Middle District of Tennessee. He was arrested in Canada because of that bench warrant, and because of the serious criminal charges against him in the United States.
5. From April 2013 through August 2013, and again from April 2014 through February 2015, Matthew was held in criminal detention facilities in Canada, administered by Correctional Services Canada.¹ To the best of my recollection, these include:
 - a. Fort Frances Jail, at 310 Nelson Street, Fort Frances, Ontario (April 2013)²
 - b. Thunder Bay Jail, at 285 McDougall Street, Thunder Bay, Ontario (later in April

2013)³

- c. Sudbury Jail, at 181 Elm Street West, Sudbury, Ontario (May 2013)⁴
- d. Toronto East Detention Centre, at 55 Civic Road, Scarborough, Ontario (later in 2013)⁵
- e. Maplehurst Correctional Complex, at 661 Martin Street, Milton, Ontario (approx. April 2014 until later 2014)⁶
- f. Toronto West Detention Centre, at 111 Disco Road, Etobicoke, Ontario (later 2014)⁷
- g. Central East Correctional Centre, at 541 Highway 36, Lindsay, Ontario (later 2014 through 2015)⁸

6. Neither Leann nor myself were detained at any time while in Canada.

7. At no time after April 8, 2013 was Matthew held in custody maintained or operated by Canadian immigration services. The only immigration detention facility I am aware of in the area is the Rexdale Immigration Holding Centre⁹, but Matthew was never detained there at any time.
