He is the author of three bestselling books: *How Would a Patriot Act?* (2006), a critique of the Bush administration's use of executive power, *A Tragic Legacy* (2007), which examines the Bush legacy, and *Great American Hypocrites* (2008), which examines the manipulative electoral tactics used by the GOP and propagated by the establishment press. His most recent book, *With Liberty and Justice for Some: How the Law Is Used to Destroy Equality and Protect the Powerful*, will be published by Metropolitan Books in September 2011. Greenwald has been a guest on several national television and radio programs including ABC's *This Week*, Fox News' *Special Report with Brit Hume*, MSNBC's *The Rachel Maddow Show*, NPR's "All Things Considered," and *The Colbert Report*.
